J. Stewart Walker, Jr. Sailing Complex, Patriots Point Road, Mt. Pleasant, SC

The J. Stewart Walker, Jr. Sailing Complex is located within the Hilton Charleston Harbor Resort and Marina; to get a feel for the layout, follow this link: <http://www.charlestonharbormarina.com/>, click "Enter", then click on "Marina Layout" under "Facilities. On the map, it is identified as "College of Charleston Basin", and lies along the starboard side of the USS Laffey.

Driving Directions (copied from <http://www.cofcsports.com/content/?/home/facilities/walker>)

From peninsular Charleston and West Ashley

Proceed east on Highway 17 North over Silas Pearman Bridge over Cooper River/harbor. Toward end of bridge bear left and remain in the left lane. Go 0.3 miles to the first traffic light, turn right onto Patriots Point Blvd. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right into marina entrance. The dock to the Sailing Center is on the back side of the parking lot.

From Mt. Pleasant

Take Highway South to last traffic light before Grace Memorial Bridge. Turn left onto G. McGrath Darby Blvd. and proceed to traffic light at intersection with Coleman Blvd. Proceed through intersection onto Patriots Point Blvd. Go



approximately 1 mile and turn right into marina entrance. The dock to the Sailing Center is on the back side of the parking lot.

From all areas north / west of Charleston, SC

Take Interstate 26-East to exit 221B (end of I-26) and follow signs to Mt. Pleasant/Hwy. 17 North. Toward end of bridge bear left and remain in the left lane. Go 0.3 miles to the first traffic light, turn right onto Patriots Point Blvd. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right into marina entrance. The dock to the Sailing Center is on the back side of the parking lot.

From all areas south of Charleston, SC

Follow Highway 17 North through city of Charleston toward Mt. Pleasant. Toward end of bridge bear left and remain in the left lane. Go 0.3 miles to the first traffic light, turn right onto Patriots Point Blvd. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right into marina entrance. The dock to the Sailing Center is on the back side of the parking lot.

Carolina Yacht Club, 50 East Bay St., Charleston, SC

From Mount Pleasant

Merge onto **I-526 E** via the ramp to **Mt Pleasant** 2.1 mi
Take exit **30** to merge onto **N Hwy-17/US-17** toward **Charleston**
Continue to follow **US-17** 5.5 mi
Take the **Morrison Dr** exit toward **E Bay St** 0.3 mi
Turn **left** at **Morrison Dr** 0.6 mi
Continue on **E Bay St** 1.8 mi
Yacht Club is on Left.

From the NORTH or WEST

I-26 E towards CHARLESTON.
Take exit **219B** toward **Morrison Dr/E Bay St** 0.3 mi
Turn **left** at **Mount Pleasant St** 0.2 mi
Continue on **Morrison Dr** 1.3 mi
Continue on **E Bay St** 1.8 mi
Yacht Club is on Left.

From the South (I-95)

Head **southwest** on **I-95 S** toward **Exit 181B** 104 mi
Take exit **86 A** to merge onto **I-26 E** toward **Charleston** 51.0 mi
Take exit **219B** toward **Morrison Dr/E Bay St** 0.3 mi
Turn **left** at **Mount Pleasant St** 0.2 mi
Continue on **Morrison Dr** 1.3 mi
Continue on **E Bay St** 1.8 mi
Yacht Club is on Left.
